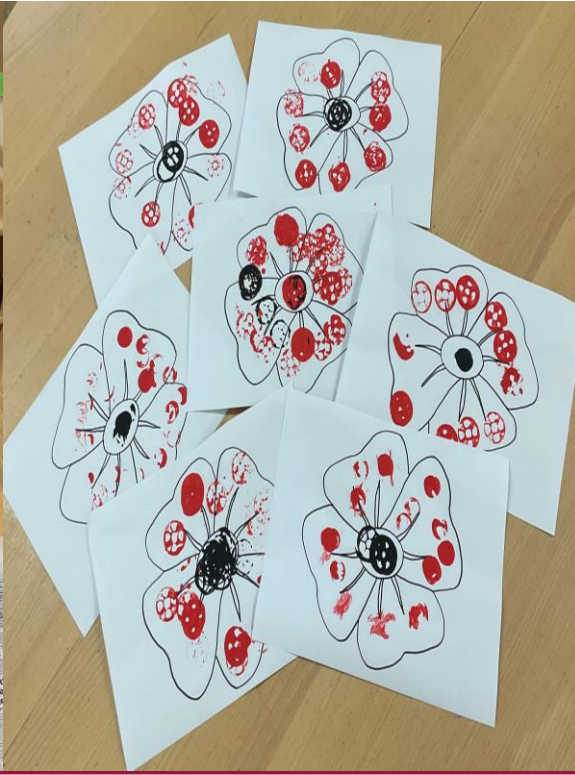

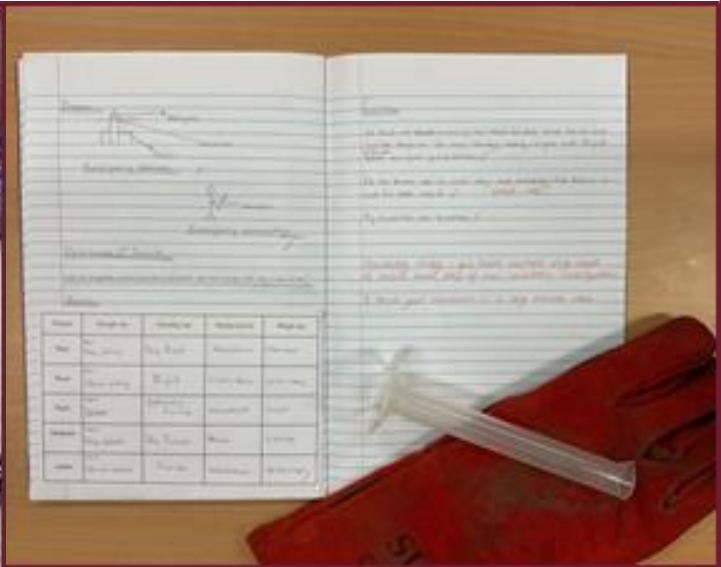
### Blwyddyn 3 & 4- Curling

### Blwyddyn 3 & 4- Testing Materials

This week we completed an investigation to find out the best material for a Roman shield. We reached the conclusion that none of the materials were perfect but that wood was the most sensible. Some children were able to recognise that a combination of materials such as wood and plastic or wood and leather would have made a better shield which is fantastic scientific thinking. The children have also experienced first hand an inconclusive result when testing for strength with weights which prompted a back up test where we could find helpful results when using the hammer and nails (which they loved!). This week we have been exploring a new way of learning in our Mathematics and Numeracy lesson. The children have been using 'Learning by questions' to further their knowledge on perimeter. Today we have focussed on finding the perimeter of rectilinear shapes. The children have been able to share which questions they found tricky and we have gone through these particular questions as a class to help their understanding. We are fast becoming perimeter experts!

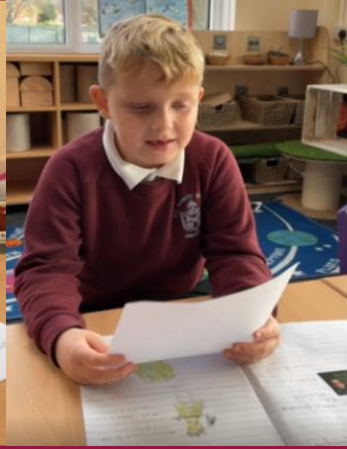
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## Blwyddyn 1 & 2- Stories
