What is phonics?

- Phonics is a method for teaching reading and writing
- It develops phonemic awareness – the ability to hear, recognise and use the sounds within words
- Children will also be taught other skills, such as whole-word recognition, book skills and a love and enjoyment of reading

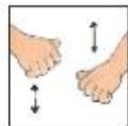
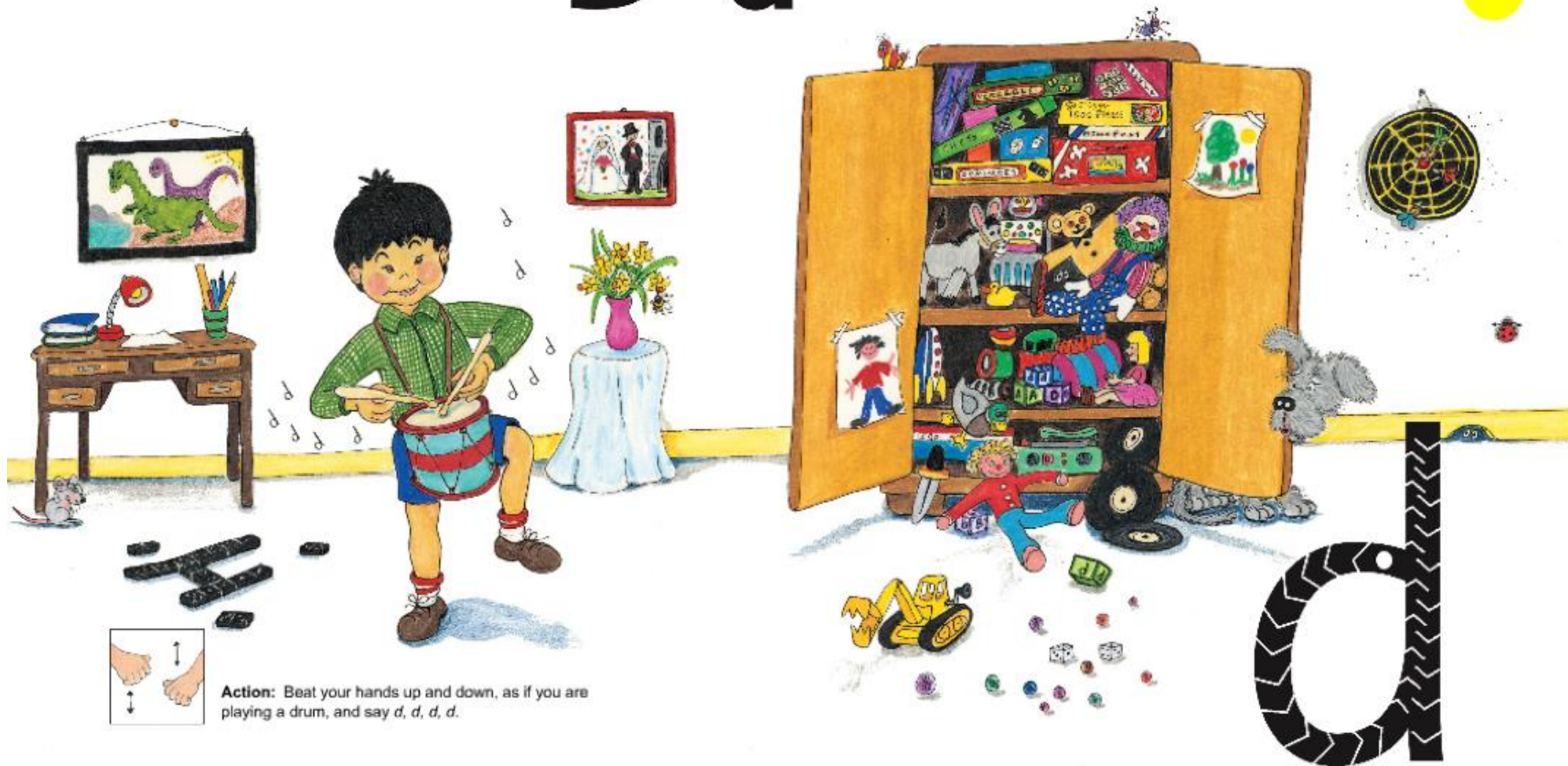


How phonics is taught in All Saints' School

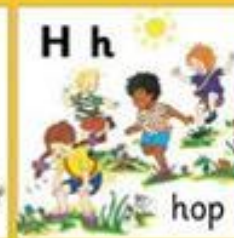
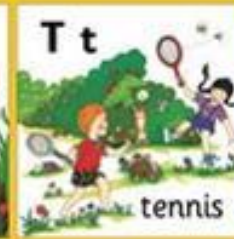


Action: Beat your hands up and down, as if you are playing a drum, and say *d, d, d, d*.



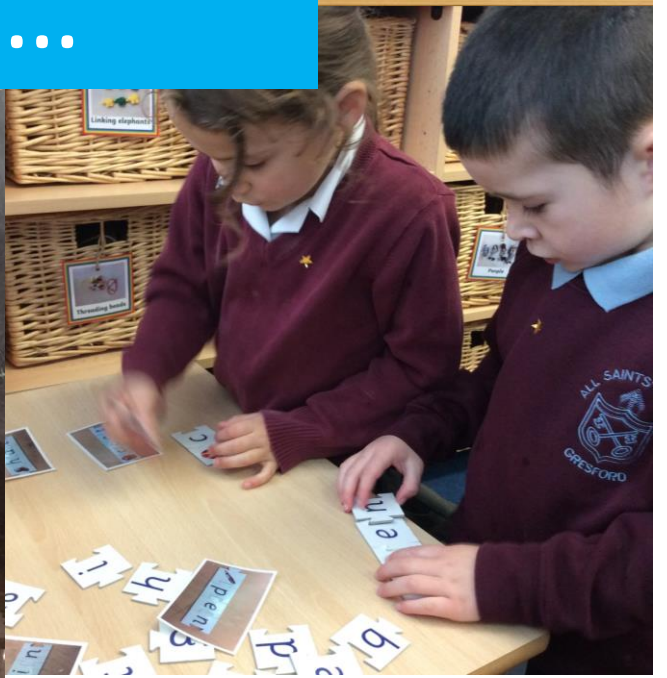
